Once a religious communal system, the heritage of these German settlers is alive and well in the outstanding restaurants, wineries, historic sites and specialty shops.

Also Mammal Hall includes a specimen of the rare giant Panda from China. "The World of Birds" features exhibits on all aspects of bird life, ecology, and evolution.
